SAGINAW was taken off the inside leaving the chute, went on to dispute the pace between rivals during the run around the bend, entered the stretch clinging to a narrow edge and dug in stubbornly to turn back the two main stretch threats to prove best. STAR OF NEW YORK strung out in the five path at the half mile pole, raced four wide around the turn, was already asked for run while fanning into the stretch, gained gradually but wasn't good enough to go by the top one. INHERIT THE GOLD broke on top, but was soon eased back off the lead, raced three wide most of the way around the turn, vied with two other opponents for the lead and held his ground well to the end. EIRE'S RUN was maneuvered over to the inside coming to the half mile pole, vied for the lead with a duo until upper stretch and weakened. STEAL THE SHOT off the inside, had no rally. RISES THE PHOENIX failed to menace. MOR CHANCES commenced to rally from the five path at the head of the stretch, but wasn't up to the task. GOOD KARMA always inside, faltered.
