FLYING TRAIN away well from the start, angled sharply towards the inside, settling into the three path soon afterwards, kept a watchful eye on the pacesetter from there, under a firm hold, inched up to bid for the lead coming to the quarter pole, cruised by, leaving the furlong grounds with a comfortable advantage, then drew off under a mild hand ride to the wire. SKY HOSOYA was hustled along the first few strides out to the gate to grab the lead, was placed under a firm hold after achieving the goal, positioned in the two path, cut the pace from the there being rated until the quarter pole, failed to keep pace with the top one after turning for home, readily succumbing to that rival, but finished well enough to reach even terms with another for the place. MAI TAI MAMA raced along the outside and rallied to dead heat for second. LADY MAUREEN never menaced. SAMMZILLA faded off a ground-saving journey. JOEEGIOVANNI steadied at the start, went four wide around the turn and gave way.
