JUST HOLD ON tucked along the inside down the backstretch, argued for control as the innermost member of a threesome, shook free after being asked for run in upper stretch, held sway, driving. STAR OF NEW YORK three wide, disputed the pace three wide, proved no match for the winner. FULTON STREET contested the pace between rivals, weakened in the final furlong. WHATEVERITTAKES strung out in the four path midway on the turn, had no rally. BROTHER IN ARMS cut the corner into the stretch and tired. ENDLESS CIRCLE three wide on the turn, folded. B G SUAVECITO tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, tired after going a half, was eased then pulled up coming to the sixteenth pole, got vanned off afterwards.
