SUNRISE SMARTY moved up willingly to the front after the start, took up residence from just off the rail while setting the splits, with another pair in close proximity directly to the outside and offering some resistance, edged away from ESCROW KID, with the rider sitting chilly as the rider of the previously mentioned opponent was asking his mount for run, got let out leading the field into the lane, left the furlong grounds still holding a comfortable lead, dug in well the last eighth to turn back NATHAN'S H Q for the decision. NATHAN'S H Q three wide departing the backstretch, was forced onto the overland route midway on the turn, swerving outward to avoid making contact with the ill-fated rival at that juncture, was still well off the inside spinning into the lane, displayed a good kick down the center of the track to garner the place. FLAT BOLD off a beat slowly, picked up the pace nearing the half mile pole, was placed two wide for the initial portion of the run around the bend, was taken over to the rail after the incident in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole, cut the corner full of momentum, was quickly angled to be outside the leader after settling into upper stretch, flattened out in the final furlong. ESCROW KID pressed the issue from the two path, got asked for a response by the five-sixteenths pole before backing away. GENERAL MAXIMUS chased three wide and broke down midway on the turn.
