ORB was patiently allowed to settle into stride proceeding down the chute, picked up the pace noticeably upon setting foot on the backstretch, moved into contention with a four wide run on the turn, was under strong handling spinning into the lane, lost none of the momentum and continued to close in on the runner up, wore down that rival in the late stages and kicked clear, kept to the task at hand. FREEDOM CHILD shook free of a tightly-bunched group shortly after departing the chute, showed the way, sitting in the two path, facing only light resistance, edged away to his biggest advantage during the later stages of the run around the bend and was set down, felt the presence of the only other rival with stretch energy with a furlong remaining, got caught, then trudged onward to secure second. REVOLUTIONARY was taken in hand and allowed to shy inward and away from an errant breaker at the start, underwent a ground-saving journey, was already under very solid encouragement by the five-sixteenths marker, proved no match for the top twosome while just winning out on show honors. TRANSPARENT came inward at the start, was angled three wide into the lane, wound up missing out on the show award. SAMPSON COUNTY chased from along the outside and tired. MAIN MAN MIKE between rivals, tired. MARKET BLASTER lost his footing at the start, yet broke near the top nonetheless, was a prominent factor for much of the way towards the head of the backstretch before backing away towards the middle of the field, departed the backstretch from three path, started tiring by midpoint, got eased after turning for home, stopped to a walk then was grabbed by the connections before reaching the wire and was subsequently walked off the track.
