Footnotes

HOPE FOR TOMORROW tracked the spurting leader three wide and unhurried, ranged up at the three-eighths as the pace tired, took over the front from the brief new leader nearing the quarter pole, edged clear to the eighth pole, had a duo charge in the late stages, dug in determined and just held on at the wire for the decision. THE LADY SAYS YES three wide mid pack under reserve, got let out at the five-sixteenths, spun three to four wide in upper stretch, kicked home with good late foot and just missed. ADRIATIC DREAM towards the rear just off the inside, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, offered up a good belated kick rallying in tandem with THE LADY SAYS YES and just missed for it all. A PRETTYDIXIE saved ground in mid pack, got let out nearing the quarter pole, offered up a mild kick for the last major share while never threatening the top. AS WELL just off the inside towards the rear, came under encouragement nearing the top of the stretch, spun four wide at that juncture, offered up mild interest but was out kicked through the lane. MLLE MARGAUX settled at the rear, got set down swinging three wide for home making mild progress before weakening in the last furlong. MIRACLEONBROADWAY just off the pace just off the inside, got set down three wide turning for home and made no impact. FREEDOM SINGS fractious prior to the start, settled four wide in mid pack, swung five wide for home under a drive and made no headway. BRICKHOUSE BABY towards the rear four to five wide, got out around the far turn at the seven-sixteenths, swung five wide for home and tired. PLATINUM AND PLUSH just off the inside in closest

pursuit of the spurting leader, assumed command when that foe stopped, led to nearing the quarter pole when overhauled by the eventual winner and tired in the stretch. JAZZINGTON three wide in pursuit leading the main flight, came under coaxing three furlongs out and gave way. MAGGIESFREUDDNSLIP spurted away two to three wide, began to weaken nearing the three-eighths pole and was overhauled then folded.
