DANCE CARD well rated on the pace just off the inside, set comfortable fractions accompanied from the outside by MY WANDY'S GIRL, was under a firm near side rein to remain in her path in the latter portions of the turn, swung two to three wide for home, shook clear under light hand urging, had the rider sneak a peak back to assess any oncoming threats, had his charge get to wandering by drifting out just past the eighth pole, used some off sided stick work more as a means to keep a straight course while under a light drive to the wire to prevail comfortably. SEA ISLAND allowed to settle at the rear while three wide, remained on hold until swinging four wide in upper stretch, offered up late foot to arrive on the scene in the final strides and procure the place while never a threat to the winner. MY WANDY'S GIRL accompanied the eventual winner just off her hind quarters in reserve from the three path, got spirited up nearing the quarter pole, swung four wide at that station, proved unable to match strides inside the final eighth with the top one while kicking on, got caught in the final strides and forced to settle for the show honors. LADY COHIBA under a firm hold just off the inside just in behind the pace, came under urging three furlongs from the wire, spun three wide into the stretch, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. BOOK REVIEW three wide towards the rear, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, improved position heading to the three-eighths pole before weakening in the stretch. JEMIMA'S PEARL saved ground settled in mid pack, got ridden along from the five-sixteenths, offered no serious response. WILDCAT'S SMILE lightly coaxed tracking inside, came under rousing at the three-eighths pole, cut the corner into the stretch, remained prominent to the eighth pole before tiring in the late stages.
