WINDSOR CASTLE was taken back and to the inside after the start, was rated along on the rail, swung to the outside entering the stretch, responded when roused, finished strongly from the outside and was clear under the wire, driving. OMMADON was bumped at the start but quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside and stayed on gamely on the rail. BUCKLE DOWN BEN was rated along between rivals, came wide for the drive and finished well outside. AIRY HILL raced close up outside, was four wide on the first turn, three wide on the second turn and stayed on well to the finish. GRIFFINITE chased the pace from the outside and tired after three quarters. MUSKRAT RAMBLE was steadied along the inside on the first turn, was crowded in upper stretch, altered course and had no rally. THE MISSING KEY bobbled at the start, was bumped, showed speed along the rail, chased the pace, drifted in upper stretch and tired. EASING ALONG was rated outside, raced four wide throughout and tired in the stretch.
