CAROLLER was outrun early, rallied four wide approaching the stretch and was along to get the place spot. BAILIE'S BAND raced close up early, put in a three wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. MIKEYMON had no response when roused. SEPTEMBER HERO was outrun early and had no rally. GRAND KIDS chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. RED DOWN SOUTH chased the pace along the inside and tired. ROYAL RAPIDS raced wide throughout and tired. NOAH JAKE tired after a wide trip.
