RUFFINO assumed a good forward position after the start, was put to a good hold while prompting the leader, crept up to that rival coming to the five-sixteenths pole, with the eventual show horse latched on directly to his outside, responded well when given his cue in upper stretch, fought his way to a narrow lead approaching the furlong marker, clung to a narrow edge throughout the remaining of the race, showing true grit in the late stages to prevail. ICABAD CRANE placed under a good hold soon after the start, sat reserved for nearly three-quarters, was asked to pick up the pace coming to the five-sixteenths pole, rallied in earnest after given stiffer encouragement turning for home, closed with good energy down the outside of the track, but could not get there in time. MINE OVER MATTER sat perched under a snug hold from the three path during the opening half, inched up into a better contending position from midpoint on the turn, still sat on hold until swinging into the stretch, battled gamely for the lead, but despite his giving it his best effort, had to settle for the show in the end. GIANT MOON bumped lightly with STUD MUFFIN shortly after the break, advanced under his own courage to settle into midpack, rode the rail until upper stretch, angled outward for the stretch drive and rallied belatedly for the last major slice of the purse. WISHFUL TOMCAT was firmly rated on the lead while setting the pace towards the inside, was asked for run when a pair of rivals drew alongside at the five-sixteenths pole, remained forwardly placed until the eighth pole and steadily tired thereafter. STUD MUFFIN bobbed after bumping lightly with GIANT MOON soon after leaving the starting gate, raced well off the inside around the turn, then drifted six wide into the stretch while tiring.
