LADY VI broke well, set the pace while keen early on fighting the rider's rating tactics, saved ground throughout the turn, lost the lead briefly while patiently handled turning for home, got spirited up near the quarter pole, cut the corner into the stretch, rallied through the furlong grounds edging clear in the final sixteenth being kept busy to the wire. LANDLASH took the overland route around the turn while improving position under her own power, came under a ride nearing the quarter pole, swung four wide under a drive, readily rallied for the place. LADY GRACNOTE in behind a foursome disputing the pace early on while saving ground, gradually angled out through the turn, straightened away five wide at the quarter pole, came home with good energy to procure the show. YAWKEY WAY prompted the pace in a four way reserved pace dispute, took command midway on the turn under no urging, swung three wide into the stretch now engaged by her rider, fought on well until the eighth pole, steadily tired in the final sixteenth while preserving the last major share. STELLALUCE was placed four wide, vied for the lead in hand with a trio to her inside down the backside, remained prominent until the final eighth, tired steadily thereafter. JUDGE MARGARET outrun early on, rode the rail throughout, came under a drive midway and was no menace. LAYLABEN prompted the pace between rivals for a half and faltered.
