Footnotes

FUDGE THE BOOKS tracked an ongoing pace fight while taking the inside route, bided time for nearly three-quarters, angled out for the stretch run and commenced to rally, narrowed in during the ensuing furlong, rolled by to take over in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and kicked clear, without much need of encouragement. TROPONIN moved up willingly under his own power to take up a forward position, was the innermost of a threesome arguing for control from the half mile pole to the five-sixteenths pole, continued the battle one on one with DEVONSHIRE once DISTANCE SKY could no longer keep pace, dug in well under rousing, proved no match for the winner during the final sixteenth but held well for the place. WINAHOLIC sparrred early with the top one before being allowed to ease back, sat within range off the disputed pace, picked up interest and turned three wide under urging into the stretch, rallied mildly to secure the show. DEVONSHIRE departed the backstretch three wide, contested the pace from there with another pair until the five-sixteenths pole, dueled with the runner up for an additional quarter before weakening. SILENT MONEY was fanned four wide into upper stretch, had no rally. DISTANT SKY disputed the pace between opponents around the bend until the five-sixteenths pole and gave way.
