Footnotes

MIDNITE SILVER in behind the pace up front initially, made a three wide bid for the lead commencing midway on the turn, stuck a nose in front turning for home still three wide, responded willingly drawing clear in the final furlong, was hand ridden in the late stages as the outcome was no longer in doubt. DUBAI GOLD tracked the pace three wide down the backside, took over the two path around the turn when that position was vacated by a tiring foe, came under a drive turning for home between rivals at the quarter pole, angled out nearing the three-sixteenths directly after MIDNITE SILVER went by, continued on displaying a good kick to secure the place while being second best. THE VIN MAN settled in behind the pace makers, maneuvered three wide around the turn coming under a drive just past midway, loomed in behind the front three lined up across the track at the quarter pole, swung out one additional path at that station, offered a mild bid to procure the show. SCORPER broke sharp and outwards at the start and was corrected, was put to a snug hold soon after and prompted the pace inside, saved ground throughout the turn, was the innermost of a threesome lined up coming to the quarter pole, was roused at that point, couldn't keep pace with the top two in the final eighth and steadily tired. TRUE LINNET trailed early on, was three wide spinning for home under a drive and gave no response. BOLD VINDICATION set a moderate pace under light coaxing between rivals, came under a heavy drive in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths, gave way.
