LOVELY LIL moved up willingly to assume a forward position, raced as a team with ALL DUE RESPECT latched on to her outside, with both at a considerable distance from off the inside for most of the way down the backstretch, was guided over to the rail nearing the half mile pole, with the aforementioned rival following suit only taking up residence in the two path, was continuously pressed by the runner up during the run around the bend, with the pilot of each mount holding something in reserve all the while, got called upon with a cluster of rivals ready to strike as the field approached the quarter pole, edged away to perhaps her biggest advantage during the ensuing furlong, dug in with good determination and under good handling to prove best. ALL DUE RESPECT made solid contact with KATY NOW at the start, went on to take up a prominent post, was rated along while pressing the issue from outside the winner for the opening three-quarters, turned for home still in close proximity to the top one and got called upon, continued onward with good energy but had to settle for place honors. C C'S PAL raced three wide and came home with good energy to grab the show. KATY NOW was bounced soundly between opponents at the start, settled near the front, departed the backstretch four wide and proceeded from there around the turn, was coaxed a bit to keep pace late on the bend, entered the stretch but needed more. RISKY RACHEL well placed and well rated between rivals for six furlongs, came up empty for the stretch drive. PERSUADING tucked over to the rail soon after the start, saved ground thereafter, was asked for some run by the five-sixteenths pole, faltered. SPA CITY PRINCESS bumped at the start, saved ground to no avail. INDIAN LEGEND was bumped between rivals, raced near the back of the pack, appeared choppy-gaited nearing the eighth pole, was soon eased and pulled up, then was subsequently vanned off.
