Footnotes

AKILINA rode the rail, was eased outward midway on the turn after gaining the necessary clearance, took off after the leader after being set down in upper stretch, made steady progress departing the furlong grounds, altered course a bit inward when YO KARAKORUM began to drift out at the sixteenth pole, then finished determinedly to prove best nearing the wire. YO KARAKORUM was rushed to grab command after breaking a beat slowly at the start, showed the way on an uncontested lead while being kept off the inside, left the furlong grounds with a sizeable advantage, began to drift out while weakening in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole which led to her being caught late. STUNNING ELECTRA underwent a four wide journey, proved no match for the top one the entire length of the stretch but held well to secure the show. HIGH CRY raced along the outside and lacked a rally. MOCHA SHAKE was no factor. RED COGNAC failed to reach a contending position. CRAFTY SHOCKED offered little. ROSIE'S RUN pursued the pacesetter three wide for a half before folding.
