COMPLIANCE OFFICER angled in early, set the pace along the rail the entire way and edged clear late. CASH'N IN DIXIE was well placed along the rail, saved ground to the turn and finished willingly. URBAN FLIGHT steadied then bobbled after clipping heels in tight between horses just after the start, was carried very wide on the first turn, raced well back, split horses while gaining on the turn and rallied belatedly along the inside. A claim of foul lodged against the winner for interference at the start was disallowed. TOO AMENABLE steadied early, tucked in, saved ground for five furlongs then closed late between horses. KARAKORUM LEGEND raced up close for a half, dropped back on the turn, swung four wide and rallied mildly. TYPHOON TYCOON steadied and was pinched back at the start, was outrun to the turn and failed to mount a strong late response. GOLD VENDETTA lodged a move from outside to reach contention on the turn and flattened out. PRINCE DUBAI steadied after being pinched back at the start and was never close thereafter. BENEATH THE CROWN pressed the pace outside the winner and gave way. TOBRUK pulled up and bore out on the first turn and was vanned off.
