CHEROKEE COUNTRY was outrun for a half, altered course to the outside at the three-sixteenths pole then unleashed a strong late run in the middle of the track to get up in the final seventy yards. GREENSPRING was unhurried early, raced well back to the turn, raced behind a wall of horses nearing the quarter pole, checked and angled to the inside at the three-sixteenths pole then finished strongly along the rail but could not get up. HATFIELD dueled along the rail into upper stretch, opened a clear advantage in midstretch, led into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. THE ROUNDHOUSE was outrun to the turn, swung four wide and rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. AH DAY was outrun for a half then closed late in the middle of the track. SEAN AVERY raced just off the pace between horses, was in traffic on the turn, lodged a bid in upper stretch and flattened out. GO GO SHOOT dueled outside into midstretch and tired. RILEY TUCKER pressed three wide for a half and gave way. FORMIDABLE chased four wide into upper stretch and faded. DRIFT KING steadied along the rail at the half mile pole and dropped back on the turn.
