Footnotes

WHY THEN bumped at the start, settled into midpack along the outside, was positioned four wide at the three-eighths pole, in preparation for the stretch drive, and with the rider still applying a firm hold, moved up nearing the quarter pole, responded positively once given her cue, grabbed the lead during the ensuing furlong, then drew off the last eighth under a light drive to the finish line. CIMINELLA saved ground throughout, was coaxed along almost from the get-go to keep pace, needed much stiffer encouragement to do so by midway on the turn, cut the corner turning for home and came home willingly to fend off the others for the place. PRINCESS CUGAT was checked after being bumped just out of the starting gate, rode the rail around the turn, remained along the inside until clearing the rival in distress in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, found his best foot once settled outside at the furlong marker to earn the show. MAGIC QUEEN bumped at the start, was no factor. MAMA DUKES came in sharply at the start, causing crowding and a chain reaction of bumps involving the nearest three rivals directly to the left side, went on to assume the left, took up residence in the two path at the half mile pole, cut the pace from there on a loosely-contested lead, briefly sputtered away nearing the head of the stretch, felt pressure by the three-sixteenths pole and readily succumbed. LOVELY LINA three wide, was urged from the half mile pole, but was never in the hunt. GLADSTONIA urged from the gate, was taken outward immediately after conceding the advantage to MAMA DUKES nearing the turn, chased towards the three path during the run around the bend, began to back off, appeared choppy-gaited in upper stretch, was taken in hand and eased across the wire for the final check.
