TO HONOR AND SERVE away in good order, showed the way on the lead as the field made their way onto the backstretch, remained under a good hold, conceding the advantage to CALIBRACHOA soon afterwards, rated kindly in the two path keeping a watchful eye on the new pacesetter, remained on hold as that pair headed for the top of the lane before being asked for run, fought his way to take over during the ensuing furlong, edged away, kept to the task at hand to the end. HYMN BOOK lagged behind early, was allowed to settle into stride, picked up interest nearing the end of the backstretch, closed the gap from the competition, at first under light coaxing, was put to stronger and stronger handling as he made his way to the quarter pole, spun four wide into the stretch and lost none of his momentum, displayed a good kick down the center of the track to garner place honors. CALIBRACHOA moved past the top one to take control upon departing the chute, was rated along the rail, with the eventual winner making his presence felt all the while just to his outside, continued along on the same scenario until the quarter pole, was called upon as the stretch duel commenced, yielded when unable to keep pace, weakened steadily thereafter into the show slot. HAYNESFIELD rode the rail, sat well placed with the rider atop with a snug hold on the the reins for the opening six furlongs, failed to fire when asked in upper stretch. CAIXA ELETRONICA raced between foes around the turn, angled out in upper stretch, made no gain. SANGAREE underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, folded.
