Footnotes

JOSTLE settled just behind the early pacesetter, moved between horses to gain a narrow lead on the far turn, extended her advantage in upper stretch, dug in when challenged in deep stretch and prevailed under strong right hand encouragement. MARCH MAGIC checked in tight at the start, raced in traffic while between horses on the first turn, moved up steadily along the rail on the backstretch, waited for room while behind horses on the turn, angled out to get clear approaching the quarter pole, checked slightly when carried out in upper stretch, made a run to challenge in deep stretch but could not overtake the winner. SHAWNEE COUNTRY raced in the middle of the pack while four wide for a half, made a run from outside to challenge midway on the turn, drifted out while battling in upper stretch then weakened under pressure in the final eighth. FINDER'S FEE trailed for five furlongs after breaking a bit slowly, made a steady run while five wide to reach contention on the turn, angled to the inside in upper stretch then flattened out. REGALLY APPEALING broke inward at the start, raced within striking distance along the backstretch, swung four wide on the turn then checked while tiring in midstretch. MADDIE MAY checked slightly leaving the first turn, was never a serious threat. MARY'S SILVER PEN showed only brief speed. BALLDO was used up setting the early pace.
