Footnotes

GREENWOOD LAKE was unhurried while trailing for five furlongs, raced well off the rail along the backstretch, rapidly closed ground from outside on the turn, circled six wide into the lane, then closed steadily under left hand urging to get up in the final strides. UN FINO VINO, fractious in the gate prior to the start, rushed up after breaking a bit slowly, moved up along the rail on the backstretch, slipped through along the inside to gain a clear advantage on the far turn, extended his margin a bit in upper stretch, continued on the front while racing a bit erratically in deep stretch then yielded grudgingly. POLISH MINER settled in the middle of the pack while three wide for six furlongs, angled four wide while gaining on the turn, made a run to threaten in upper stretch and finished willingly between horses to gain a share. SCOTTISH HALO was unhurried for six furlongs while saving ground, rallied along the inside to reach contention in upper stretch then finished evenly while in a bit tight behind UN FINO VINO in the late stages. TRADITIONALLY was pinched back slightly at the start, raced well back for five furlongs, angled four wide while closing some ground on the turn and lacked a strong finishing response. MANDARIN MARSH forced the pace from outside to the turn then checked while tiring behind horses in midstretch. WINDRUSH set the pace slightly off the rail to the far turn and gave way. PRINCE WAR CLOUD showed only brief speed and was eased while far back in the late stages.
