Footnotes

LOOKING AROUND rated off the pace outside, started his bid six wide on the turn, sustained a long drive through the stretch and determinedly maintained a slight edge through the final furlong. CRONKITE rated close inside, took a short lead three wide near the quarter pole, was briefly clear entering the stretch, dueled gamely from the eighth pole and grudgingly yielded. TAMA was a bit slow getting into stride, settled outside on the backstretch, advanced position four wide on the turn then proved empty in the stretch. SPEEDING JIM was kept close in the five path, raced evenly saving some ground through the turn then leveled out in mid track. SWEET PRINCE chased the pace from the three path then faded into the turn. COLD CLAIM moved to contention on the inside, lacked room nearing the quarter pole then weakened. LEGEND OF GOLD raced outside and never factored. AMERICA'S STORM rated the pace just off the rail then gave way leaving the quarter pole. ROYAL MARQUET kept up in the six path on the backstretch then had no response rounding the turn. THE SENATE (GER) lost contact early, eased.
