ROCKPORT HARBOR broke running, quickly showed in front, set the pace along inside, responded when joined by GALLOPING GROCER on the second turn, dug in resolutely on the rail in the stretch and held off that rival after a long drive. GALLOPING GROCER raced with the pace from the outside while in hand, moved up to engage the winner entering the second turn and fought it out gamely to the finish. KILLENAULE raced close up early, put in a three wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. STORMY JIM raced in hand early, rallied three wide on the second turn and had nothing left for the stretch drive. FATHER WEIST was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused. PAVO chased the pace along the inside and tired after the opening three quarters.
