MASALA T saved ground from the get go, had ample room to launch a rally after turning for home, surged to the front to open up a clear advantage by midstretch, then continued to edge away while being kept busy. REGAL OFFICER was bounced around at the start, saved ground thereafter and was along to be a clear second. HIGH FIVES chased the pacesetter and weakened during the final furlong. DANCING CALLING outfinished weak rivals during the stretch drive. SHIP'S PIANO steadied at the start and was no factor. KARAKORUM TORNADO forwardly placed for a half, tired. COUNT BY FIVE was bumped at the start, set the pace while well off the inside and gave way after going a half. LIZARD was through after going a half. MONEY TO BURN faded after a half. PRIME OBSESSION bumped at the start, took the overland route and stopped during the final furlong.
