**Footnotes**

DORIAN WILL was eased back early, settled along the inside, waited on the turn, swung out and edged clear in the late stages. STROLL FOR ACURE was outrun to the turn, swung three wide and finished well for the place. CARDIFF ROAD stalked three wide, gained a slim lead in upper stretch and weakened. VICTORY MARCH checked early on the rail, was under a firm hold, made a run to challenge on the turn and tired. ALLABOUTMACK was outrun for a half, gained four wide on the turn and finished evenly. TIRE KICKER failed to threaten. BURNISHED COPPER saved ground to the turn and raced in traffic in upper stretch. THE PLOT THICKENS was used up setting the early pace. INTERFERENCE saved ground and tired.
