NO SUCH WORD underwent a three to four wide journey, moved up to challenge for the lead coming the three-eighths pole, was the outmost of a foursome spread across the track, continued to apply the pressure, fought her way to a clear lead by the eighth pole and edged away under intermittent encouragement to the wire. AWESOME MARIA established command soon after the start, vied for the lead, with a multitude of rivals applying pressure along the way, still held the lead turning for home, failed to keep up with the top one thereafter, but dug in gamely to procure place honors. SEEKING THE TITLE dove to the inside, reaching it in time for the run around the opening bend, sat reserved along the inside until approaching the three-eighths pole, angled outward, having now been placed to a drive, continued her bid from the four path at the head of the stretch and came home willingly to earn the show. JOANIE'S CATCH raced along the outside and rallied mildly to grab the last major share. QUIET TEMPER three wide around both turns, tired. DUBAI DANCER rank being rated, raced off the inside and came up empty for the stretch run. BELLE OF THE HALL prompted between rivals for much of the running and gave way.
