JERSEY TOWN off to an alert beginning, had the rider cast several glances at the rivals directly to his inside, was placed under a snug hold and taken back, patiently stalked the front runners, perched in the three path for nearly three-quarters, moved up nearing the quarter pole, gearing up for the stretch drive, closed in during the run through the furlong grounds, struck the front upon reaching the eighth pole, clinging to the narrowest of edges, surrendered it while starting to drift outward, in response to strong left handed pressure, continued onward gamely, inched his way back towards a determined HAYNESFIELD, getting a nose down in time to prevail in the final jump. HAYNESFIELD away in good order, moved up after the start to assume a good forward position, patiently prompted the pacesetter from the outside, with the rider applying rating tactics, prepared to make a bid for the lead approaching the quarter pole, battled on nearly even terms with the top one nearing the eighth pole, took over soon after leaving the furlong grounds, dug in with good determination, only to get nipped in the final stride. GIROLAMO moved into midpack soon after the start, raced off the inside, between rivals, under a firm hold, responded well once given his cue in upper stretch, rallied with good energy, shadowed the top one towards the outside during the final sixteenth, en route for show honors. BRIBON (FR) three wide around the turn, was asked to pick up the pace coming to the five-sixteenths pole, squeezed his way into the four path at the head of the stretch, then came home willingly to earn the final major share. FRIEND OR FOE strung out four wide on the turn, was put to a prolonged drive but made little headway on the front runners. SOARING EMPIRE reluctant to load, saved ground and failed to reach a contending position. VINEYARD HAVEN set the pace along the inside, came under heavy pressure nearing the quarter pole and succumbed. MUSKET MAN four wide around the turn, was outrun. HALF METAL JACKET took the overland route and trailed.
