### Footnotes

HEY VALENTINA in reserve while prompting the pace, was placed three wide in the turn sparring with VALUABLE LADY, drifted in when roused in the vicinity of the quarter pole, bumping ROCK STAR ROYALTY who was splitting rivals at that point causing that rival to in turn bobble and shut off VALUABLE LADY on the rail, edged clear coming to the eighth pole, drifted in again slightly, continued on well from there being kept busy to the wire. MARIE'S BABE bided time in midpack early on while in the two path, began to be hand urged near the five-sixteenths, steadily closed on the front around the turn, swung three wide for home now fully engaged by the rider, rallied readily down the stretch, securing the place while cutting into the winner's margin throughout. ROCK STAR ROYALTY chased a pace fight while saving ground around the turn, ranged into prominence nearing the quarter pole, hesitated a moment before splitting rivals at that station, was bumped when HEY VALENTINA came in slightly at that juncture, causing her to bobble and in turn shut off VALUABLE LADY, altered course to the two path near the eighth pole for a clear lane, and kicked home evenly for show. AUSABLE CHASM broke in at the start and was corrected by the rider, chased the pace while saving ground, swung four wide at the head of the lane and offered a mild bid for the last major share. TATOO ME saved ground through the turn, came under a long drive and passed tired rivals in the final eighth. MONEY MAGNET three wide around the turn, offered little. VALUABLE LADY disputed the pace from the two path, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, attempted to cut the corner when ROCK STAR ROYALTY bobbed and came in shutting off the rail when bumped by HEY VALENTINA, was sharply taken up, lost all momentum, fading in the stretch drive. SEASIDE SLEW raced wide throughout and was never in contention.
