LADY'S LUNAR LUCK contently rode the pocket while tracking the pacesetter, was put to some encouragement and squeezed in between rivals as the field headed towards the top of the lane, kicked in with good energy after settling in for the stretch drive, spurted away to a clear lead nearing the eighth pole, but with several rivals in full flight and in hot pursuit, dug in with good determination to fend them all of and prove best. DOWNTOWN HOTTIE underwent a three to four wide journey, came home with good courage to garner place honors. STRIKEALINETHRUIT took the inside route, slipped off the rail just past the five-sixteenths pole, displayed a good kick en route to earning the show award. AQUIFOLIA raced from off the inside and rallied mildly to secure the last major check. VICTORYAT LAST got bumped at the start, raced three wide around both turns, remained a forward factor until midstretch before weakening. CATINGUA three wide on the first turn, worked out a tuck into the two path soon after entering the backstretch, sat within range in midpack down the backstretch, fell back steadily during the run around the far turn while appearing one-paced, staged a mild comeback after turning for home to improve position by out finishing weak and tired ones. KATY'S OFFICE GIRL left the inside nearing the end of the backstretch, made no serious bids. WATCH THE

SUN RISE broke out a step, was grabbed hold and yanked away from the bumping incident at the start of the event, moved up willingly under her own power to establish control, cut the pace, well rated from the inside and on open lead, came under heavy pressure nearing the quarter pole, readily succumbed to it and tired. ZELLWEGER was bumped soundly between opponents at the start, took the inside route, was under a drive cutting the corner into the lane, came up empty. FLYING SAPPHO was bumped at the start, loosely accompanied the pacesetter from the outside for nearly three-quarters and wilted.
