Footnotes

TWILIGHT TIME was unhurried early, closed the gap while saving ground on the turn, rallied along the rail to challenge in midstretch then edged clear under steady left hand urging. NEVER WINK raced in the middle of the pack for a half, rallied between horses leaving the turn then closed steadily to clearly best the others. LORD OF TIME raced far back early, was behind horses while saving ground on the turn, launched a rally along the inside entering the stretch, angled out while gaining in midstretch then rallied belatedly to gain a share. WAKE AT NOON dueled heads apart along the backstretch, opened a clear advantage on the turn, set the pace into midstretch and weakened. DARWIN was outrun for a half after breaking slowly then failed to threaten while improving his position. TRUE FORCE dueled early along the rail and gave way on the turn. DANCE MASTER forced the pace three wide for a half and gave way. GONE SUPER raced wide and tired. GADIR was never a factor. CHIEF J STRONGBOW was outrun after breaking slowly and was pulled up in the stretch.
