HUDSON LANDING pressed the pace from outside, opened a clear lead in midstretch but couldn't hold the winner safe. DREAMING BLUE raced well back to the turn and rallied belatedly. WORLD RECORD settled just off the pace between horses, lodged a bid to challenge in midstretch and weakened. DON CAVALLO raced up close along the rail into midstretch and tired. UNPRECEDENTED raced well back, raced in traffic in upper stretch and lacked a late response. PLEAD never reached contention while racing wide. D'ORO DANCER was used up setting the early pace. PRECIPICE TRAIL never reached contention. HOT PURSUIT faded after going five furlongs.
