BUDDY'S SAINT settled in hand soon after the start, moved out while just off the pace along the backstretch, lodged a strong move midway on the turn, took charge leaving the five-sixteenths pole, shook loose while angling to the rail in upper stretch then drew away under a vigorous hand rider before being taken under wraps in the final twenty yards. PEPI KNOWS tucked in along the rail in the early stages, was reserved for five furlongs while saving ground, swung four wide while gaining on the turn, took up chased after the winner in upper stretch but was no match for that one while clearly best of the others. CITRUS KID took the lead on the first turn, set the pace on the rail for six furlongs, relinquished the lead to the winner on the turn and gradually tired thereafter. FUDGE TRUFFLE raced well back while saving ground, angled out on the turn and lacked a late response. HOMEBOYKRIS pressed the pace in the two path to the turn and gave way. GRAND RAPPORT trailed for most of the way.
