MAKEMINECHOCOLATE away well from the starting gate, took up residence in the pocket, patiently tracked the pacesetter under a firm hold for over three-quarters, spun into the lane with a clear alleyway along the inside awaiting her, drove through under encouragement en route to the front, took over just past the eighth pole and held sway. MYTHICAL YARN saved ground, raced within striking distance while placed under a good hold until the stretch, followed the winner to reach a contending position with an eighth to go and displayed good energy from there to procure the place. SPLIT POT lagged behind during the early stages, left the backstretch from the three path, began to pick up pace during the latter stages of the run around the second bend, was stacked six wide of the lane before rallying in earnest, was expertly pulled off a rival in time to avoid serious contact, in the vicinity of the eighth pole, then sustaining the momentum, finished well to grab the show. APRILMAYJUNE rated prompting the leader, was outkicked. BULLET BABY rated on the lead until the quarter pole, gave way leaving the furlong grounds. BRETTON WOODS lacked the necessary stretch response. LOST AT DAWN swung five wide into lane, bumped with OLIVE EYE coming to the eighth pole and showed little interest thereafter. WISE CHOICE saved ground and was no factor. SIMPLE WESTERN three wide around both turns, tired. OLIVE EYE attempted a four wide run to reach a contending position on the far turn, appeared to be flattening out when bumped midstretch.
