SHIMMERING FOREST off alertly, took control before leaving the elbow chute, aided by considerable crowding and bumping at the break, sped off under his own power to a lengthy advantage, sailed along, uncontested until nearing the five-sixteenths pole, was let out a notch when put to the test by a pair of rivals, shook free, reasserting himself en route to a clear advantage by midstretch, then maintained a safe winning margin under active handling to the finish line. TOM KITTEN bumped at the start, settled into midpack, tucking along the rail, made a middle move along the inside to improve position down the backstretch, continued to bide time until the stretch, was called upon after turning for home, failed to dent the leader's margin but continued on willingly for the place. ROCK AMERICA within striking distance for nearly three-quarters, unleashed a three wide bid coming to the five-sixteenths pole, but could not sustain it after entering the stretch. PAPA W BODIE was taken in hand after being bumped between rivals at the start, appeared a bit unsettled during most of the run down the elbow chute, continued to be a handful to control, acting rank while taking the inside route down the backstretch, was put to a drive at the three-eighths pole, was guided off the inside in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, then continued on willingly to secure the final major slice of the purse. LAUNCH N RELAUNCH was bumped shortly after the start, recovered and moved up into a forward position, loosely stalked the leader during the opening half, began to close the gap from the front runner after departing the backstretch, put pressure on the leader coming to the five-sixteenths pole, only to be soon shaken off, steadied, while wedged in tight quarters between rivals in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, was put to light encouragement from that point and flashed interest during the final sixteenth. LUIGI P forwardly placed for three-quarters, lacked the necessary stretch response. GRAND

PIANO MAN put to a prolonged drive entering the far turn, came up empty. SUPREME SERENE bumped at the start, never threatened. LINDSEY'S BUCK three wide around the first turn, tired after completing a half. PATENT PENDING TOM squeezed back at the start, swung three wide into the backstretch, proceeded to race four wide around the second bend and folded.
