LITTLE ROCKET tracked the front runners while saving ground, moved up towards the leader late on the turn, was put to solid encouragement prior to being angled to the outside of the pacesetter, collared that opponent to become the new leader by the eighth pole, drew well clear under good handling. ROCKIN MANDY was hustled from the starting gate to assume a forward position, chased three wide around the turn, got outfinished by the top one but held on well enough to secure second. QUIT SMOKIN four wide departing the backstretch, was five wide and already urging entering the stretch, lacked the needed response. START IT UP was in the three path and pulling on the left side of the bit after taken hold of approaching the half mile pole, dropped back slightly as a result with the momentary loss of momentum, began to pick up the pace noticeably late on the turn, was fanned six wide, commencing the stretch drive the widest of all, got straightened away and rallied en route to gaining the last major check. DESERT TRAVELER broke alertly and took the early advantage, tucked along the inside, showed the way while being hounded by a trio of rivals, spread across the track from paths two through four, had the top one apply pressure of her way own entering the stretch, relinquished to that opponent before reaching the end of the furlong grounds, tired steadily in the last eighth. ACROBATIC TACTIC contested the pace from between rivals until the top of the lane before backing away. PENCIL PAPERS cut the corner into the stretch and faltered. ALTAR contested the pace as the widest of four on the turn and gave way.
