Footnotes

READYTODEFER sat entrenched in the two path, went at it head to head with the runner up early down the backstretch, had the rider attempt to take back but was unable to do so, got let out a notch and after matching strides with DRIVEN BY SOLAR went on to assume control by the crown of the turn, scampered away to a comfortable lead by the quarter pole, emerged from the furlong grounds in possession of his biggest advantage, maintained almost all of it, while being kept busy. DRIVEN BY SOLAR engaged in two brief skirmishes with the winner in the initial stages, got shaken off for good by the three-eighths pole, continued to hug the rail down the backstretch and fended off NIGHT MANEUVER to preserve the place. NIGHT MANEUVER was steadied coming to the end of the backstretch, as OLD MAN MEESE was settling into the two path at that juncture, got going properly in short order and was guided into the three path near midpoint on the turn, spun a bit wider and under strong handling into the stretch, lacked a solid closing punch. OLD MAN MEESE bobbled awkwardly at the start, chased towards the two path on the turn and gave way. VERBOSITY underwent a three wide pursuit, was under solid encouragement by the five-sixteenths pole marker, folded. SMOKIN HERO off a beat slowly, was never involved. MINESWEPT was outrun while saving ground until the quarter pole.
