**Footnotes**

PALACE sat reserved in midpack from off the inside for nearly a half, picked up interest when asked to while starting to get angled outward from the five-sixteenths marker, went wider and wider until in the five path by the top of the lane, took off earnest after the front runners, outkicked a pair of them leaving the eighth pole after an abbreviated skirmish to prove best. STRAPPING GROOM took up the role of primary pursuer shortly after the start, undergoing the task from the two path and from between rivals after about halfway around the bend, got set to encouragement prior to spinning into the stretch, fought his way to a clear advantage by the end of the run through the furlong grounds, got collared by the top one a sixteenth later, continued onward in a willing manner to secure second. THE LUMBER GUY three wide, contended for the lead as the widest of a threesome from the three-eighths pole until upper stretch, held on well to the end to grab the show award. CAIXA ELETRONICA drifted inward and made some contact with SATURDAY'S CHARM after coming out of the gate, failed to get motivated despite being put to brisk encouragement for the majority of the way down the backstretch, vacated the inside route and got angled three wide into the stretch, came home with some belated interest for the last major check. SAGE VALLEY underwent a four wide pursuit, having been placed to a hard drive on the turn, tired. SATURDAY'S CHARM lightly bumped after the start, raced from off the inside, keeping a ground-saving CAIXA ELECTRONICA company for most of the initial half, made no impact. B SHANNY saved ground, was put to a drive after completing a half, came up empty. JAKE N ELWOOD cut the pace from the inside, was put to a stern test approaching the five-sixteenths pole and was soon called upon, relinquished the lead before making it to the eighth pole and faltered.
