Footnotes

AT THE WHEEL was reserved for a half, rallied along the rail to reach contention in midstretch then closed steadily along the inside to get up in the final twenty yards. PURE PRECISION checked slightly while being bumped at the start, rushed up from outside to contest the early pace, made a run to challenge at the quarter pole, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch, continued on the front into deep stretch then yielded grudgingly. RUM SPLASHER raced in the middle of the pack for a half, angled six wide while gaining at the top of the stretch, drifted out in upper stretch then rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. NICKIE'S AFFAIR settled just off the early pace, lodged a mild rally while four wide to reach contention approaching the stretch then finished evenly. MISTER BRAVO raced within striking distance between horses into upper stretch and lacked a strong closing response. PERUVIAN SUMMER broke inward a bit at the start, failed to threaten with a mild late rally. JIMMIE J was bumped a bit at the start, rushed up along the rail to gain the early advantage, set the pace into upper stretch and weakened. MORETHANASTAR took up while being pinched back at the start and failed to threaten thereafter. COACH KNIGHT closed the gap a bit on the turn then flattened out. PASSIONATE SOLDIER never reached contention while six wide. SMOLDER pulled up in distress on the turn and was vanned off.
