ALKE contested the pace from the outside, dug in gamely in the stretch and was clear under the wire, driving. BLACK SILK (GB) raced close up while between rivals and finished gamely to earn the place award. EPIC was outrun early, rallied five wide on the turn and finished gamely outside. GREATNESS raced close up along the inside and lacked a rally. HOUSTON'S PRAYER raced inside early on, altered course in the stretch and was going well outside late. COURTING CONCORDE contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. WESSEX (ARG) was outrun early, raced wide and had no rally. PORT AU PRINCE had no response when roused. MORE HECK chased the pace while three wide and tired. LE BOURGET chased the pace while four wide and tired.
