### Footnotes

BORROWING BASE raced well back, circled four wide while rallying on the turn, rapidly closed the gap in midstretch and wore down the runner-up under steady urging. ATONED was under a firm hold, track three wide to the turn, gained a slim lead in midstretch, fought back inside and yielded grudgingly. JANE'S KID was under a firm hold, saved ground most of the way, lacked room in midstretch and finished willingly. CRITICAL ACCLAIM raced between horses, was in traffic while gaining on the turn and rallied mildly. MALIBU MOONSHINE slipped through on the rail to take the lead after a mile, led into upper stretch and weakened. DENVER moved out early, raced three wide in hand, was in traffic in midstretch and tired late. UNBRIDLED DANGER opened a long lead early, tired on the turn. TOMCITO raced wide on the turn and lacked a rally. NEW FANDAN (BRZ) trailed throughout.
