Footnotes

SCHILLERETTE contently stalked the front runners while racing four wide, was roused in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole and accelerated towards the leader, grabbed command during the initial portion of the stretch run, left the eighth pole comfortably in front and remained so the rest of the way. LILY LYNN unhurried in the opening stages while taking the inside route, commenced to angle outward leaving the midway point on the turn, wound up four wide by the top of the lane, proved no match for the winner while finishing well clear of the others for the place. GRACE AND COURAGE rated inside for three-quarters, had no answer when challenged by the top one in upper stretch, yielded readily and steadily tired. WISE CHOICE got off last, moved up under her own power to become the primary pursuer shortly after entering the backstretch, kept up the pursuit from between rivals on the turn, gave way after going six furlongs. BAY HEAD BEAUTY chased three wide and tired.
