Footnotes

SECRET BID raced at a considerable distance from off the inside throughout, picked up interest and cruised up into a contending position from the three path on the turn, swung one path wider into the stretch and was set down for the drive home, forged to the front a short distance past the eighth pole and drew clear. SPARTIATIS came out, making solid contact with the nearest opponent at the start, patiently prompted the pacesetter from the two path for much of the opening half, raced as a a team with that foe upon reaching the turn, took command before arriving at the quarter pole, drifted three wide into the stretch and got fully asked, surrendered to the winner with slightly less than a furlong to go, continued onward willingly for the place. KING OF BROADWAY bumped soundly at the start, sat reserved two wide for nearly three-quarters, commenced the stretch from the three path, flattened out in the final furlong. MEDIA KID along the inside, was asked for some run by the five-sixteenths marker, raced through the furlong grounds with the rider applying strong pressure on the right side, weakened in the late stages. BRED TO BOSS swung three wide into the stretch, lacked the needed response. CAT MAN FU three wide and roused by the five-sixteenths pole, made no headway. BUDDY'S SMART bobbed after getting bumped and squeezed back at the start, took the inside route on the turn and was outrun. GRAFFITIST vied for command from the inside and gave way.
