### Footnotes

THE TRUTH AND K G hustled from the gate, vied inside lightly coaxed along, got set down at the head of the lane, shook away from his main pace foe and edged clear under a vigorous hand drive to the wire. DENZEL tossed his head then was bumped at the start by MEET THE METS who broke inwards, came under hustling to settle just off the pace just off the inside, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, offered up a mild kick for the place honors while never threatening the winner. MEET THE METS vied two to three wide through the turn while in hand, got set down at the quarter pole and was shaken off by the eventual winner nearing the furlong grounds, dug in to keep on for the show offering mild energy to the wire. APEX bumped at the start by BROTHER BOB who came out at the break, saved ground towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, offered no serious response while passing tired foes for the last major share. BERNIE THE JET tracked the pace along the inside, came under urging at the five-sixteenths and weakened in the stretch. DIGHTON three to four wide towards the rear, got ridden along from the five-sixteenths, angled five wide for home and made no headway. BROTHER BOB broke out at the start carrying out and bumping APEX, chased three wide towards the rear spirited up from three furlongs out and made no impact. STEALTH STEED forwardly placed three to four wide in close pursuit, faded through the turn pushed along from midway, cornered four wide for home and tired.
