Footnotes

UNDERTHEMOONLIGHT took up the chase from the two path, was put to encouragement nearing the quarter pole, entered the stretch and closed in on the leader, out dueled that opponent to take over in the final seventy yards, then edged away. KEEP RIGHT was put to some hand urging early down the backstretch to take up a forward position, vied for the lead from along the inside, got asked for run a couple of jumps before arriving at the end of the bend, showed good determination before relinquishing with under a sixteenth remaining. IT'S EASY at or near the overland route throughout, showed good courage en route for the show. NOON TIME SHOWER was taken hold after ducking out at the start, contended for control from the two path, got displaced midway on the turn, held on reasonably well thereafter earning the last major check. LEMME ROCK in the three path, disputed the pace as the widest of three on turn before giving way. TRUERICEPUDDING driven three wide into the stretch, came up empty. STORIED LADY reached out greenly during the very earliest stages, rode the rail on the turn, fanned outward to be five to six wide with a furlong remaining, made no headway. MAYBRY'S FORTUNE three wide and set down by the five-sixteenths pole, folded. GOLDSTANDARDLADY saved ground and tired.
