PARTY TO PARTY rated close in the four path, sustained a long stretch bid and edged ahead through the final yards. KINNELON advanced outside taking the early lead then angled toward the inside rating the pace, moved clear through the upper stretch, picked up the winner a sixteenth out and grudgingly yielded. LIL LINZER raced unhurriedly toward the inside, saved ground through the turn, angled out leaving the quarter pole and made a steady outside bid for show. TUDOR COURT rated just off the pace in the three path, was eased out entering the stretch, made a mild bid then leveled out late. MAGIC MATTY broke through the gate prior the start, chased the pace from the inside then weakened saving ground. LET'S PUNT chased the pace from the four path and finished evenly. CLEVER PROSPECTOR chased the pace, saved ground through the turn then proved empty in the stretch. JO DINAH never factored.
