Footnotes

TOCCT dueled early along the rail, moved to the outside of BHAM midway down the backstretch, forced the pace to the three-eighths pole, edged closer on the turn, surged to the front in upper stretch, opened a clear advantage a furlongs out then edged away under steady left hand urging. BHAM rushed up from outside to contest the early pace, opened a clear advantage along the backstretch, set the pace under pressure leaving the turn, relinquished the lead to the winner in upper stretch then continued on willingly to clearly best the others. EMPIRE MAKER checked a bit after bobbling at the start, was unhurried early, raced in traffic behind horses along the backstretch, split rivals while four wide to launch his bid on the far turn, made a run to reach contention midway on the turn but couldn't sustain his rally. OUTER REEF settled in good position while saving ground along the backstretch, moved within striking distance along the inside leaving the far turn then flattened out approaching the top of the stretch. ONE COLONY checked slightly at the start and was never close thereafter. WACKY FOR LOVE raced in close contention between horses to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. TITLE CONTENDER failed to threaten while five wide throughout. CELTIC MEMORIES checked in tight between horses leaving the backstretch, angled in on the far turn and lacked a further response.
