QUEEN'S TRIOMPHE raced in hand while outside early, advanced three wide on the second turn, responded when roused and drew clear late under a drive. MESSAGE RED was outrun early, rallied three wide on the second turn and finished gamely outside to earn the place award. PRINCESS DIXIE was outrun early, rallied along the inside on the second turn and finished well while between rivals in the stretch. GOLDEN DAMSEL was hustled out to a clear lead, set the pace along the inside and gave way in the final furlong. FLAG PIN was outrun early, raced wide and had no rally. ALONG CAME MARY raced inside and tired in the stretch. BOARD ELLIGIBLE had no response when roused. MARC'S RAINBOW chased the pace along the inside and tired after three quarters. ALLEGED WHISPER tired.
