PRINCE DUBAI raced off the pace, moved up outside a rival on the far turn, angled widest at the top of the lane and made a late run outside for the win. FRENCH TRANSITION tracked inside, angled out at the top of the stretch and finished well outside. JITALIAN raced three wide off the pace, made a four wide bid on the far turn and rallied mildly for third. STEALTH MISSILE set the pace on the inside, shook clear in upper stretch and yielded. BINDLE STICK was steadied repeatedly between rivals on the clubhouse turn, steadied again on the backside, angled out in the stretch and rallied mildly. TRUE LINNET did not factor. FREGATA pressed the pace and faded. STORM ISLAND stalked outside, bid three wide on the far turn and tired. MERLIN BAY raced four wide early and faded.
