### Footnotes

CAPTAIN GAUGHEN patiently prompted the pacesetter from the two path until the end of the backstretch, advanced towards that opponent and took over by the quarter pole, went onward for an additional sixteenth before getting called upon, just reached the wire in time to preserve the decision. CAMPOGIOVANNI three wide on the second bend, unleashed a good kick down the center of the course, missed. IRISH JADE saved ground until past the three-eighths pole, swung three wide into the lane, lacked the needed late response to compete with the top twosome. MR ALGEBRA three wide on the opening bend, was hung out one path wider on the subsequent one, mustered up a mild response to secure the last major check. MISTER DOOLEY broke on top and maintained control, cut the pace from the inside, got displaced by the winner heading for the quarter pole, steadily backed away thereafter. PROFESSOR CHAOS quickly guided over to the rail, was no factor. SUN WORSHIPPER raced from off the inside and was outrun. RIVER TUNE strung out four wide on the first turn, remained from off the rail throughout, gave way after going six furlongs. SUMMER PLACE TO BE chased from near the two path until the end of the backstretch, was along the inside route and under encouragement prior to the quarter pole, tired. HOLY ENDEAVOR three wide on the opening bend, folded.
