ALONG CAME MARY rated close on the inside, rallied on the rail nearing the quarter pole then dueled clear while drifting outward. PRINCESS DIXIE rated back off the rail, angled out making her bid four wide on the final turn, closed to midstretch then steadied late when shut off and finished clear in place. TEXTBOOK METHOD rated a clear pace, was tested off the rail from the quarter pole, dueled to midstretch, lost momentum briefly then showed no further response. CRITICAL EYE raced unhurriedly early, made her bid in the four path on the final turn and gained mildly. INDY GLORY rated close in the three path, gave chase through the final turn then gave way in the drive. BUT rated close two deep then faded through the final turn. SMOOTH BLUES never factored. LOVELY AMANDA kept up early in the five path then faded rounding the final turn. A brief stewards inquiry provided no change.
